Recycle

Campbell Construction recycles its construction waste during the Green construction process. All construction waste is comingled in a designated waste receptacle. The receptacle is sent to a recycling facility to be sorted, and around 90% of our construction waste on LEED sites is diverted from landfills.

Purchase of Materials

Campbell Construction purchases materials that contain high percentages of recycled content when applicable, and we also try to purchase materials that are regionally harvested and manufactured. We do this to reduce the strain on natural resources that harvesting raw materials and transporting long distances cause.

Design

Campbell Construction designs buildings to be efficient and minimize material waste. We utilize recycled materials in our designs such as structural steel and metal studs. We also minimize site disturbance by orienting our buildings to fit the existing grades as best as possible and by setting construction limits that do not extend beyond the necessary space needed to construct the project.

Green isn't a new concept for Campbell. We are a leader in green building construction. As a green construction company, we have been practicing high performance building long before going green or sustainable became mainstream. Campbell has become a leading green construction company by employing craftspeople trained and educated in green commercial construction.

Our Role in Green Commercial Construction

As a green construction company, Campbell believes every project is an opportunity to evaluate and potentially reduce environmental impact.

Campbell Construction places a high value on safety. We aim to protect our Associates, Clients, Client's Customers/ Staff, and Subcontractors. We also strive to reduce injuries and to decrease work-time loss.

Quarterly Safety Meeting

Campbell Construction conducts a safety meeting each quarter for our employees. In these meetings the employees are given updates concerning our safety program such as our current EMR, any lost time injuries we have had, and what has been seen during jobsite inspections.

Campbell Construction provides safety training at each quarterly meeting on a range of topics. Some examples of the training topics provided are PPE, Fall Protection, Electrical Safety, Trenching and Excavation Safety, Hazardous Communication, and many others. The training is performed either by Campbell Construction or by other professionals that specialize in the field being trained.

Weekly Toolbox Talks

Each week Campbell Construction's Field Managers conduct Toolbox Talk safety training with their employees they are responsible for. The topics of the Toolbox Talks are similar to the safety training topics covered in the quarterly meeting, and are intended to be a refresher that keeps everyone thinking about their work environment and being safe.

OSHA 10

All Campbell Construction field employees have completed the 10-hour OSHA course in Construction Safety and Health.

OSHA 30

All Campbell Construction managers have completed the 30-hour OSHA course in Construction Safety and Health.
